## ASSEMBLY HISTORY

Over 59 years ago, PCL was formed due to concerns with California's lack of planning around growth. While the economy was booming, air and water pollution increased dramatically, our precious natural resources were not being protected, and sprawling development was committing future generations to expensive infrastructure investments.

PCL's efforts have been instrumental in the creation of a comprehensive set of laws that effectively manage and mitigate the environmental impacts of future growth. Over the years, PCL has successfully raised a staggering \$35 billion, which has been used to safeguard wetlands, floodplains, groundwater, wildlife corridors, and agricultural lands from encroaching sprawl. Additionally, PCL has played a significant role in securing nearly \$8 billion for the development of transit systems such as BART, MetroLink, and other light rail systems.

Since its inception in the mid-1970s, PCL's annual environmental policy gathering has been a beacon of change. This platform has brought together activists, advocates, and opinion leaders for over five decades, leading the way in addressing California's environmental challenges. Today, PCL's Assembly is a hub of insightful and impactful panels, focusing on the crucial issues we must confront to combat climate change. The recent Assemblies have been catalysts for numerous advancements in environmental policy, with almost a dozen bills emerging from the panels and conversations.

PCL is focused on building a more livable California by protecting our environment, enhancing equity for all Californians, supporting sustainable economic development, and using our tax dollars more efficiently.
