Climate Change Wins and Losses in Just-Ended Legislative Session

Last Friday, in the final hours of this year's legislative session, the California Legislature sent to the Governor's desk **SB 350, an historic piece of climate legislation**, and one of which its authors and supporters can be extremely proud. When the Governor signs the bill, as expected, California will be on track to double the efficiency of its electricity and natural gas use, and to procure 50% of its power from renewable energy sources, both by the year 2030. **These actions keep California at the forefront of climate leadership in the nation, and as a beacon of progressive climate policy for the rest of the world.**

Earlier in the week, Senate President pro Tem Kevin de León had amended SB 350 to remove the section of the bill that called for a 50% reduction in
